The Social Care Commitment is a promise made by adult social care employers to provide people who need care and support with high quality services. It's made up of seven 'I will' statements with associated tasks that everyone who signs up to the commitment needs to do.

It's a great way of setting out clear goals and shared values for everyone in the organisation as well as helping to give a structure to inductions, appraisals and supervisions. It can also provide supporting evidence for Care Quality Commission (CQC) inspections and the Care Certificate.
