It was 1989 when my parents, Brian and Jackie Richardson, first welcomed some young adults with learning disabilities into our home at 88 Clarence Avenue in Kingsthorpe, Northampton. They created a supportive, family environment and a stable home for the people in their care. In fact, two of them are still living with us today. And since then, we have helped more than 230 people to live happy and fulfilling lives.

In 1994, we opened our first home for adults with acquired brain injuries, recognising that they too could benefit from the unique environment we created.

Then in 2003, it was time for the next generation of the family to step up. So my husband, Greg Cheater, and I took over the day-to-day management of the business.

As our services grew, so did our multi-disciplinary team of neuro specialists. We are very proud of our high-calibre team of therapists and the Managers who run our homes. We now have six residential care homes, accommodating up to 78 adults with acquired brain injuries, learning disabilities and complex needs.

We remain true to the values established back in 1989, which have been fundamental to our success. We aim to accomplish:
